

Worth Parish Council

Since the beginning of the COVID-19 Lockdown the Parish Council, in a majority of those who replied, agreed to carry out the following:

- Carry out duties via email with a majority of 3 responding to items such as planning applications, emergency works to Parish Council land etc
- Allow the Clerk to authorise cheques that have already been approved by the Council in the 2020/21 budget, such as the Clerks salary, water bills for the allotments etc
- Agreement from the Clerk and Chair, plus a majority to make any additional payments not included in the budget
- To allow the Clerk to continue her duties such as replying to residents' concerns, reporting issues and enquiries to other authorities and continue the day to day running of the Council, while liaising with the Chair
- The Chair decided to postpone the Annual Parish Meeting (TBC) and following guidelines from higher Government agreed to hold the Annual General Meeting in May 2021 unless a Councillor has any issues throughout the year to vote to hold this meeting sooner, at present no concerns.
- The Chair decided not to hold a virtual Council meeting at this time as the Council was functioning via email and telephone at present, but this may change as the weeks go on.
