"Council resolves to agree in respect of the Worth Parish Hall running costs that:

(i) Worth Parish Council will continue to pay the annual lease rental payment (currently £600.00 per annum, reviewable at five and ten-yearly intervals). This is payable directly to the Church (the Lessors), on January 1st each year.

(ii) The Worth Parish Hall Management Committee will pay the annual insurance (£986.78) for 2022/23. Insurance for the year 2023/24 and thereafter will be subject to annual review and discussion.

(iii) When exterior repairs are required, discussions on funding should take place between WPHMC and WPC on an ad hoc basis depending on the severity, cost and scope of what is required.

(iv) WPHMC will continue to fund internal repairs"
